- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.12 6 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) The rules adopted under this chapter must allow a sixteen- or seventeen-year old minor to work the same number and frequency of hours during the school year as would be permitted during school vacations or holidays if:
 - (a) The minor is enrolled in a bona fide college program; or
- 12 (b) The minor is enrolled in a career and technical education 13 program and the work is performed for an employer approved by the 14 program.
- 15 (2) For purposes of this section, "career and technical education 16 program" refers to a work-based learning program approved by the 17 office of the superintendent of public instruction or the minor's 18 school district, including but not limited to core plus programs.
