- 1 AN ACT Relating to establishing protections for citizens
- 2 participating in the initiative and referendum process; and adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 29A.84 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29A.84 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) No person may engage in the following activities within 25 8 feet of a person collecting signatures for or signing or attempting 9 to sign an initiative or referendum petition, unless each person 10 consents to the other person's engagement in such activities:
- 11 (a) Suggest or persuade or attempt to suggest or persuade any 12 person to sign or decline to sign an initiative or referendum 13 petition;
  - (b) Engage in any practice which interferes with the freedom of a person to collect signatures or sign an initiative or referendum petition; or
- 17 (c) Engage in any activities restricted under (a) and (b) of this 18 subsection through electronic amplification located more than 100 19 feet from a person collecting signatures for or signing or attempting 20 to sign an initiative or referendum petition, if the person is 21 capable of being understood at that distance.
