- 1 AN ACT Relating to allowing small business establishments in
- 2 residential zones; and adding a new section to chapter 35.21 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 35.21 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A city or town must allow neighborhood cafés to be permitted 7 in any zone allowing residential uses provided that the following 8 conditions are met:
- 9 (a) The total gross floor area of the café may not exceed 2,000 10 square feet;
- 11 (b) Outdoor seating is limited to no more than 30 percent of the 12 gross floor area of the café;
 - (c) There are no drive-through facilities at the café;

- (d) The café must offer food if alcoholic drinks are offered; and
- 15 (e) Hours of operation are limited to between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 16 p.m.
- 17 (2) For the purposes of this section, "neighborhood café" means
- 18 an establishment that serves a limited menu of food items and does
- 19 not contain more than 2,000 square feet of gross floor area.
