- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.16.090 and 2003 c 400 s 4 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Examinations for licensure under this chapter shall be conducted
- 8 at such times and places as the director determines appropriate.
- 9 Examinations shall consist of tests designed to reasonably measure
- 10 the applicant's knowledge of safe and sanitary practices and may also
- 11 include the applicant's knowledge of this chapter and rules adopted
- 12 pursuant to this chapter. The director may establish by rule a
- 13 performance examination in addition to any other examination. The
- 14 director shall establish by rule the minimum passing score for all
