- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.16 RCW to read as follows:

- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act applies both retrospectively and 9 prospectively.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect April 1, 2024.
