- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.42.100 and 2005 c 218 s 4 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
  - (1) A person is guilty of the crime of endangerment with a controlled substance if the person knowingly or intentionally permits a dependent child or dependent adult to be exposed to, ingest, inhale, or have contact with ((methamphetamine)):
- 11 <u>(a) Fentanyl or synthetic opioids, or the smoke of a substance</u>
  12 <u>that the person knows, or reasonably should know, contains, or is</u>
  13 contaminated with, fentanyl or synthetic opioids; or
- 14 <u>(b) Methamphetamine</u> or ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or anhydrous 15 ammonia, including their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, that 16 are being used in the manufacture of methamphetamine, including its 17 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers.
- 18 (2) Endangerment with a controlled substance is a class B felony.
