- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.101.230 and 2021 c 323 s 15 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
  - enforcement activities and who do not qualify as "criminal justice personnel" or "law enforcement personnel" under RCW 43.101.010 shall be provided training under this chapter if:  $((\frac{1}{2}) (\frac{1}{2}))$

Tribal police officers and employees who are engaged in law

- 10 tribe is recognized by the federal government, and (( $\frac{(b)}{(2)}$ ) the
- 11 tribe pays)) (2) tribal agencies with tribal officer certification
- 12 agreements with the commission under RCW 43.101.157 shall reimburse
- 13 the commission for 25 percent of the cost of training its personnel.
- 14 <u>Tribes without current written tribal officer certification</u>
- 15 agreements with the commission shall pay to the commission the full
- 16 cost of providing such training. The commission shall place all money
- 17 received under this section into the criminal justice training
- 18 account.
