- 1 AN ACT Relating to avoiding interest arbitrage charges on bond
- 2 proceeds in the capital vessel replacement account; amending 2022 c
- 3 186 s 406 (uncodified); and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that delays in the procurement of additional ferry boat vessels have correspondingly
- 7 delayed the time frame in which the proceeds of bonds issued for that
- 8 purpose may be spent. The legislature further finds that, absent
- 9 timely legislative action, the state may be subject to internal
- 10 revenue service arbitrage rebate penalties for failure to expend the
- 11 bond proceeds in a timely manner. It is the intent of the legislature
- 12 to repurpose the bond proceeds to allow the department of
- 13 transportation to spend the funds within internal revenue service
- 14 timelines.
