- 1 AN ACT Relating to leaving a child unattended in a motor vehicle;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 9.91 RCW; prescribing penalties; and
- 3 making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.91 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 A person who has the care and custody, whether temporary or
- 8 permanent, of a minor child under the age of nine years, and
- 9 knowingly leaves the child unattended by an adult in a parked
- 10 automobile, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of \$100,000, or as much thereof as
- 12 may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal biennium ending June
- 13 30, 2025, from the general fund to the department of health, for the
- 14 purposes of promoting awareness of this act and the dangers inherent
- 15 in leaving young children unattended in a vehicle.
