- 1 AN ACT Relating to responding to electric vehicle fires; creating
- 2 a new section; and making an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The Washington state patrol, in
- 5 consultation with the department of ecology and local fire protection
- 6 districts, must study the following elements of electric vehicle
- 7 fires:
- 8 (a) Impacts to the environment and proximate residential areas,
- 9 and health impacts to responding firefighters;
- 10 (b) Best practices for fire response; and
- 11 (c) Best practices regarding clean-up and disposal efforts.
- 12 (2) By January 1, 2025, the Washington state patrol must report
- 13 to the appropriate committees of the legislature study findings and
- 14 any resulting policy or legislative recommendations.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of \$150,000, or as much thereof as
- 16 may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30,
- 17 2025, from the state patrol highway account to the Washington state
- 18 patrol for the purposes of this act.
