- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- RCW 9.02.110 and 2022 c 65 s 3 are each amended to read 5 6 as follows:
  - The state may not deny or interfere with a pregnant individual's right to choose to have an abortion prior to viability of the fetus, or to protect the pregnant individual's life or health.
    - (2) A physician, physician assistant, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or other health care provider acting within the provider's scope of practice may terminate and a health care provider may assist a physician, physician assistant, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or other health care provider acting within the provider's scope of practice in terminating a pregnancy as permitted by this section.
- 17 (3) A physician assistant, advanced registered nurse 18 practitioner, or any other health care provider that is not a 19 licensed physician must carry a medical malpractice insurance policy
