- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 29A.68
  RCW to read as follows:
- 8 No candidate seeking federal elective office may be kept off of any Washington state ballot due to an allegation of federal 9 10 insurrection or rebellion unless that candidate has been convicted 11 under a federal criminal statute for insurrection or rebellion, and that criminal statute for insurrection or rebellion explicitly 12 enables section 3 of the 14th Amendment of the United States 13 Constitution. Any attempt at keeping such a candidate off of the 14 15 ballot shall be a violation of RCW 29A.84.630.
