- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 7.68.803 and 2021 c 269 s 3 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) No costs incurred by a hospital or other emergency medical 8 facility for the examination of the victim of domestic violence 9 assault involving nonfatal strangulation, when such examination is 10 performed for the purposes of gathering evidence for possible 11 prosecution, shall be billed or charged directly or indirectly to the 12 victim of such assault. Such costs shall be paid by the state 13 pursuant to this chapter.
 - (2) The department must notify the office of financial management and the fiscal committees of the legislature if it projects that the cost of services provided under this section exceeds the amount of funding provided by the legislature solely for the purposes of this section.

- 7 (c) The number of police reports filed by victims of suspected nonfatal strangulation who received services under this section.
