7 a concert titled "Get the Party Started" to celebrate its 20th
8 anniversary; and

9 WHEREAS, Seattle Women's Chorus has demonstrated a tireless
10 commitment to inclusion, diversity, acceptance, and social justice;

12 WHEREAS, Seattle Women's Chorus performances celebrate the power
13 of women in the face of diminishing rights, intolerance, and
14 division; and

15 WHEREAS, Seattle Women's Chorus has toured the western United
16 States and led community engagement projects for Women for Women
17 International, Lambert House, Central Area Development Association,
18 and many other organizations; and

19 WHEREAS, Seattle Women's Chorus has had the pleasure of
20 performing with respected artists such as Bernice Johnson Reagon,
21 Chely Wright, Kathy Najimy, and comedy duo Dos Falloia;

23 Washington State Senate hereby thank Seattle Women's Chorus for its

1 cultural and artistic contributions to the state and region, and
2 recognize the special importance of this inspiring performance
3 and momentous anniversary; and
