- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71.05.620 and 2018 c 201 s 3028 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The files and records of court proceedings under this chapter 7 and chapter 71.34 RCW shall be closed but shall be accessible to:
 - (a) The department;
 - (b) The department of social and health services;
- 10 (c) The authority;

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- 11 (d) The state hospitals as defined in RCW 72.23.010;
- (e) Any person who is the subject of a petition;
- (f) The attorney or guardian of the person;
- 14 (g) Resource management services for that person; ((and))
- 15 (h) Service providers authorized to receive such information by 16 resource management services; and
- 17 <u>(i) The Washington state patrol firearms background division to</u>
- 18 conduct background checks for processing and purchasing firearms,
- 19 <u>concealed pistol licenses</u>, <u>alien firearms licenses</u>, <u>firearm rights</u>
- 20 <u>restoration petitions under chapter 9.41 RCW, and release of firearms</u>
- 21 from evidence, including appeals of denial.
