1 AN ACT Relating to administering educational service district 2 elections; and amending RCW 28A.310.090 and 28A.310.100.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 28A.310.090 and 2022 c 79 s 7 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 Candidates for membership on an educational service district 7 board shall file declarations of candidacy with the Washington state school directors' association on forms prepared by the association. 8 Declarations of candidacy may be filed ((by person or by mail not)) 9 10 no earlier than the first day of September, nor later than the 16th 11 day of September. The association may not accept any declaration of 12 candidacy that is not ((on file in its office or is not postmarked)) 13 received before the 17th day of September.

14 Sec. 2. RCW 28A.310.100 and 2022 c 79 s 8 are each amended to 15 read as follows:

Each member of an educational service district board shall be elected by a majority of the votes cast at the election for all candidates for the position. All votes shall be cast ((<del>by mail</del> <del>addressed to</del>)) <u>on forms developed by</u> the Washington state school directors' association and no votes shall be accepted for counting if

1 ((postmarked)) received after the 16th day of October ((or if not postmarked or the postmark is not legible, if received by mail after 2 the 21st day of October following the call of the election)). The 3 executive director of the Washington state school directors' 4 association and an election board comprised of three persons 5 6 appointed by the association shall count and tally the votes not 7 later than the 25th day of October in the following manner: Each vote cast by a school director shall be accorded as one vote. If no 8 candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, then, not later than 9 the first day of November, the executive director of the Washington 10 state school directors' association shall call a second election to 11 12 be conducted in the same manner and at which the candidates shall be the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast. No 13 vote cast at such second election shall be received for counting ((if 14 postmarked)) after the 16th day of November ((or if not postmarked or 15 16 the postmark is not legible, if received by mail after the 21st day 17 of November)) and the votes shall be counted as hereinabove provided on the 25th day of November. The candidate receiving a majority of 18 votes at any such second election shall be declared elected. In the 19 event of a tie in such second election, the candidate elected shall 20 21 be determined by a chance drawing of a nature established by the 22 executive director of the Washington state school directors' 23 association. Within 10 days following the count of votes in an election at which a member of an educational service district board 24 25 is elected, the executive director of the Washington state school directors' association shall certify to the county auditor of the 26 headquarters county of the educational service district the name or 27 28 names of the persons elected to be members of the educational service 29 district board.
