AN ACT Relating to the waiver of the fundamentals examination for professional engineer and land surveyor licensing applicants by comity; and amending RCW 18.43.100.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 18.43.100 and 2019 c 442 s 12 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (1) The board may, upon application and the payment of a fee 8 determined by the board, issue a certificate ((without further examination)) as a professional engineer or land surveyor to any 9 10 person who holds a certificate of qualification of registration issued to the applicant following examination by proper authority, of 11 any state or territory or possession of the United States, the 12 District of Columbia, or of any foreign country, ((provided: (1) That 13 the applicant's qualifications meet the)) if: (a) The applicant meets 14 15 all requirements of ((the)) this chapter and the rules established by 16 the board to qualify for such waiver, and $\left(\frac{2}{2} + \frac{1}{2}\right)$ (b) the 17 applicant is in good standing with the licensing agency in said 18 state, territory, possession, district, or foreign country.

19 (2) The board shall waive the fundamentals examination for 20 applicants who have passed the national council for examiners for 21 engineering and surveying principles and practice examination, have

- 1 met the experience and education requirements established by the
- 2 board, and are in good standing with the licensing agency in a state,
- 3 <u>territory</u>, <u>possession</u>, <u>district</u>, <u>or</u> <u>foreign</u> <u>country</u>.
