1 AN ACT Relating to work performed by institutions of higher 2 education; and amending RCW 28B.10.350 and 28B.50.330.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 28B.10.350 and 2009 c 229 s 2 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (1) When the cost to The Evergreen State College or any regional 7 state university of any building, construction, or renovation, 8 remodeling, or demolition, other than maintenance or repairs, will 9 equal or exceed the sum of ((ninety thousand dollars)) <u>\$110,000</u>, or 10 ((forty-five thousand dollars)) \$90,000 if the work involves one trade or craft area, complete plans and specifications for the work 11 12 shall be prepared, the work shall be put out for public bid, and the 13 contract shall be awarded to the responsible bidder who submits the 14 lowest responsive bid.

(2) Any building, construction, renovation, remodeling, or
demolition project that exceeds the dollar amounts in subsection (1)
of this section is subject to the provisions of chapter 39.12 RCW.

18 (3) The Evergreen State College or any regional or state 19 university may require a project to be put to public bid even when it 20 is not required to do so under subsection (1) of this section. Any

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1 project publicly bid under this subsection is subject to the 2 provisions of chapter 39.12 RCW.

3 (4) Where the estimated cost of any building, construction, 4 renovation, remodeling, or demolition is less than ((ninety thousand 5 dollars)) <u>\$110,000</u> or the contract is awarded by the small works 6 roster procedure authorized in RCW 39.04.155, the publication 7 requirements of RCW 39.04.020 do not apply.

(5) In the event of any emergency when the public interest or 8 property of The Evergreen State College or a regional or state 9 university would suffer material injury or damage by delay, the 10 11 president of such college or university may declare the existence of 12 an emergency and, reciting the facts constituting the same, may waive the requirements of this section with reference to any contract in 13 order to correct the condition causing the emergency. For the 14 15 purposes of this section, "emergency" means a condition likely to 16 result in immediate physical injury to persons or to property of the 17 college or university in the absence of prompt remedial action or a 18 condition which immediately impairs the institution's ability to 19 perform its educational obligations.

(6) This section does not apply when a contract is awarded by the small works roster procedure authorized in RCW 39.04.155 or under any other procedure authorized for an institution of higher education.

23 Sec. 2. RCW 28B.50.330 and 2009 c 229 s 1 are each amended to 24 read as follows:

(1) The boards of trustees of college districts are empowered in 25 accordance with the provisions of this chapter to provide for the 26 27 construction, reconstruction, erection, equipping, demolition, and major alterations of buildings and other capital assets, and the 28 acquisition of sites, rights-of-way, easements, improvements, or 29 30 appurtenances for the use of the aforementioned colleges as 31 authorized by the college board in accordance with RCW 28B.50.140; to be financed by bonds payable out of special funds from revenues 32 hereafter derived from income received from such facilities, gifts, 33 bequests, or grants, and such additional funds as the legislature may 34 provide, and payable out of a bond retirement fund to be established 35 by the respective district boards in accordance with rules of the 36 state board. With respect to building, improvements, or repairs, or 37 38 other work, where the estimated cost exceeds ((ninety thousand dollars)) \$110,000, or ((forty-five thousand dollars)) \$90,000 if the 39

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1 work involves one trade or craft area, complete plans and 2 specifications for the work shall be prepared, the work shall be put 3 out for a public bid, and the contract shall be awarded to the 4 responsible bidder who submits the lowest responsive bid. Any project 5 regardless of dollar amount may be put to public bid.

6 (2) This section does not apply when a contract is awarded by the 7 small works roster procedure authorized in RCW 39.04.155.

8 (3) Where the estimated cost to any college of any building, 9 improvements, or repairs, or other work, is less than ((ninety 10 thousand dollars)) <u>\$110,000</u>, or ((forty-five thousand dollars)) 11 <u>\$90,000</u> if the work involves one trade or craft area, the publication 12 requirements of RCW 39.04.020 do not apply.
