1 AN ACT Relating to restricting the possession, purchase,
2 delivery, and sale of certain equipment used to illegally process
3 controlled substances; amending RCW 9.94A.518; adding a new section
4 to chapter 69.50 RCW; creating a new section; and prescribing
5 penalties.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50
8 RCW to read as follows:

9 (1) It is unlawful for any person to possess, purchase, deliver,
10 sell, or possess with intent to sell a tableting machine or
11 encapsulating machine knowing, or under circumstances where one
12 reasonably should know, that it will be used to manufacture,
13 compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, or otherwise introduce
14 into the human body a controlled substance, other than cannabis, in
15 violation of this chapter.

16 (2) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a class C
17 felony.

18 (3) For the purposes of this section:

19 (a) "Encapsulating machine" means manual, semiautomatic, or fully
20 automatic equipment that can be used to fill shells or capsules with

1 powdered or granular solids or semisolid material to produce coherent
2 solid contents.

3 (b) "Tableting machine" means manual, semiautomatic, or fully
4 automatic equipment that can be used to compact, compress, or mold
5 powdered or granular solids or semisolid material to produce fused
6 coherent solid tablets.

7 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9.94A.518 and 2022 c 16 s 5 are each amended to read
8 as follows:

30 that is either heroin or narcotics

32 69.50.4013)

33 Unlawful Use of Building for Drug
34 Purposes (RCW 69.53.010)

35 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act may be known and cited as the
36 Tyler Lee Yates act.
