1            AN ACT Relating to state route number 501; and amending RCW  
2 47.17.640.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.17.640 and 1991 c 78 s 1 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            A state highway to be known as state route number 501 is  
7 established as follows:

8            Beginning at a junction with state route number 5 at Vancouver,  
9 thence northerly by way of Lower River Road and an extension thereof  
10 to Ridgefield(~~(, thence easterly to a junction with state route~~  
11 ~~number 5 in the vicinity south of La Center)~~). (~~That portion of~~  
12 ~~state)~~) State route number 501 from the northerly junction of N.W.  
13 Lower River Road to the Ridgefield city limits is designated "the  
14 Erwin O. Rieger Memorial Highway." The department may enter into an  
15 agreement with the Port of Vancouver, Clark county, or the United  
16 States Army Engineers, or any combination thereof, to obtain material  
17 dredged from the Columbia river and have it stockpiled at no expense  
18 to the state.
