- 1 AN ACT Relating to making expenditures from the budget
- 2 stabilization account for declared catastrophic events; creating a
- 3 new section; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** On August 19, 2023, the governor declared
- 6 a state of emergency in all counties due to threats to life and
- 7 property from existing and threatened wildfires.
- 8 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES—
- 9 **FIRES.** The sum of \$21,143,000 is appropriated from the budget
- 10 stabilization account for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, and
- 11 is provided solely for fire suppression costs incurred by the
- 12 department of natural resources during the 2023 fire season. For
- 13 purposes of RCW 43.88.055(4), the appropriation in this section does
- 14 not alter the requirement to balance in ensuing biennia.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 16 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of
- 17 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes
- 18 effect immediately.
