<u>EFFECT:</u> Requires a city or county that adopts a home energy performance report requirement to allow low-income home sellers to obtain the required information from a utility company at no cost. Removes the option for cities and counties to require additional criteria on a home energy performance report. Allows a property to be listed for sale without a home energy performance report if a qualified home energy auditor is not available to conduct the assessment within 10 business days and the report is completed before the sale is finalized.
