1 On page 5, after line 22 of the striking amendment, insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 104. A new section is added to chapter 28A.
4 320 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) School districts are prohibited from permitting an
6 individual who committed a crime listed in subsection (2) of this
7 section from volunteering in a position where they will have
8 regularly scheduled unsupervised access to persons with
9 developmental disabilities or groups of minors as described in RCW
10 28A.400.303(3).

11 (2) Subsection (1) of this section applies upon a guilty plea or
12 conviction for any of the following crimes:

13 (a) Crimes involving domestic violence;

14 (b) Crimes involving harassment, stalking, coercion, or
15 exploitation of minors;

16 (c) Crimes involving arson of schools, government facilities, or
17 properties where children congregate;

18 (d) Crimes involving murder, manslaughter, or aggravated
19 assault; or

20 (e) Crimes involving conspiracy to commit, or an accomplice to
21 commit, any crime specified in (a) through (d) of this subsection.

22 (3) This section governs school operation and management under
23 RCW 28A.710.040 and 28A.715.020, and applies to charter schools
24 established under chapter 28A.710 RCW and state-tribal compact
25 schools subject to chapter 28A.715 RCW."

EFFECT: Prohibits school districts, charter schools, and state-
tribal compact schools from permitting any individual who committed

listed crimes from volunteering in a position where they will have regularly scheduled unsupervised access to small groups of minors or persons with developmental disabilities. Includes crimes involving domestic violence, crimes involving exploitation of minors, and crimes involving arson of properties where children congregate, among others.
