1 On page 14, after line 9 of the striking amendment, insert the  
2 following:

4 "Sec. 302. RCW 28A.150.240 and 1979 ex.s. c 250 s 5 are each  
5 amended to read as follows:

6 (1) It is the intended purpose of this section to guarantee that  
7 the certificated teaching and administrative staff in each common  
8 school district be held accountable for the proper and efficient  
9 conduct of classroom teaching in their school which will provide  
10 students with the opportunity to achieve those skills which are  
11 generally recognized as requisite to learning.

12 (2) In conformance with the other provisions of Title 28A RCW, it  
13 shall be the responsibility of the certificated teaching and  
14 administrative staff in each common school to:

15 (a) Implement the district's prescribed curriculum and enforce,  
16 within their area of responsibility, the rules and regulations of the  
17 school district, the state superintendent of public instruction, and  
18 the state board of education, taking into due consideration individual  
19 differences among students, and maintain and render appropriate  
20 records and reports pertaining thereto((-))i

21 (b) Maintain good order and discipline in their classrooms at all  
22 times((-))i

23 (c) Hold students to a strict accountability while in school for  
24 any disorderly conduct while under their supervision((-))i

25 (d) Require excuses from the parents, guardians, or custodians of  
26 minor students in all cases of absence, late arrival to school, or  
27 early dismissal((-))i

1 (e) Give careful attention to the maintenance of a healthful  
2 atmosphere in the classroom(~~(-)~~);i

3 (f) Give careful attention to the safety of the student in the  
4 classroom and report any doubtful or unsafe conditions to the building  
5 administrator(~~(-)~~);i

6 (g) Evaluate each student's educational growth and development and  
7 make periodic reports thereon to parents, guardians, or custodians and  
8 to school administrators;i and

9 (h) Work with families to provide information related to, and  
10 support the implementation of, RCW 28A.605.005, the parents' bill of  
11 rights as established in Initiative Measure No. 2081.

12 Failure to carry out such requirements as set forth in subsection  
13 (2)(a) through (~~(+g)~~) (h) above shall constitute sufficient cause for  
14 discharge of any member of such teaching or administrative staff."  
15

EFFECT: Requires the certificated teaching and administrative  
staff in each common school to work with families to provide  
information related to, and support the implementation of, the  
parents' bill of rights as established in Initiative Measure No.  
2081.

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
