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6 On page 11, after line 35, insert the following:

7 "(18) \$23,178 of the general fund-state appropriation for fiscal
8 year 2027 is provided solely for implementation of House Bill No. 1092
9 (children/controlled sub.) to ensure that children facing abuse,
10 severe neglect, serious physical harm, or exposure to high-potency
11 synthetic opioids or other illicit substances are removed from
12 dangerous environments. If this bill is not enacted by June 30, 2026,
13 the amounts provided in this subsection shall lapse."

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15 On page 27, line 22, increase the legal services revolving
16 account-state appropriation by \$1,012,000

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18 On page 27, line 29, correct the total.

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20 On page 35, after line 13, insert the following:

21 "(34) \$1,012,000 of the legal services revolving account-state
22 appropriation is provided solely for implementation of House Bill No.
23 1092 (children/controlled sub.) to ensure that children facing abuse,
24 severe neglect, serious physical harm, or exposure to high-potency
25 synthetic opioids or other illicit substances are removed from
26 dangerous environments. If this bill is not enacted by June 30, 2026,
27 the amounts provided in this subsection shall lapse."

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2 On page 318, line 37, increase the general fund-state
3 appropriation for fiscal year 2027 by \$4,672,000

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5 On page 319, line 1, increase the general fund-federal
6 appropriation by \$1,230,000

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8 On page 319, line 6, correct the total.

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10 On page 326, after line 13, insert the following:

11 "(30) \$4,672,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for
12 fiscal year 2027 and \$1,230,000 of the general fund-federal
13 appropriation are provided solely for implementation of House Bill No.
14 1092 (children/controlled sub.) to ensure that children facing abuse,
15 severe neglect, serious physical harm, or exposure to high-potency
16 synthetic opioids or other illicit substances are removed from
17 dangerous environments. If this bill is not enacted by June 30, 2026,
18 the amounts provided in this subsection shall lapse."

EFFECT: Increases ongoing funding in the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Office of Attorney General, and the Department of Children, Youth, and Families Children and Families Services program for the implementation of House Bill No. 1092 (children/controlled sub.).

FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases General Fund - State by \$4,695,178.

Increases General Fund - Federal by \$1,230,000.

FOUR-YEAR OUTLOOK EXPENDITURE EFFECT:

Increases Near General Fund-State by \$13,814,534.

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
