3 (ix) Two tribal representatives appointed by the governor. The
4 representatives must be members of a federally recognized Indian
5 tribe. One tribal representative shall represent the portion of the
6 state lying east of the summit of the Cascade mountains, and one
7 tribal representative shall represent the portion of the state lying
8 west of the summit of the Cascade mountains. When appointing tribal
9 representatives, the governor shall solicit and consider nominees
10 from each of the federally recognized Indian tribes in Washington.
11 The governor shall collaborate with federally recognized Indian
12 tribes on the selection of the tribal representatives; and

13 (x) Two members from farmworker organizations appointed by the
14 governor. One member shall represent a farmworker organization based
15 in the portion of the state lying east of the summit of the Cascade
16 mountains and one member shall represent a farmworker organization
17 based in the portion of the state lying west of the summit of the
18 Cascade mountains"

EFFECT: • Adds two tribal representatives appointed by the Governor to the Joint Legislative Task Force on Reducing Regulatory Stress for Agricultural Producers. One tribal representative must be from Eastern Washington and one tribal representative must be from Western Washington.

• Adds two members from farmworker organizations appointed by the governor to the Joint Legislative Task Force on Reducing Regulatory Stress for Agricultural Producers. One member must be from an organization based in Eastern Washington and one must be from an organization based in Western Washington.
