3 Beginning on page 18, line 30, after "offender" strike all
4 material through "~~disposition~~)" on page 19, line 12 and insert ":

5 (a) (~~Is adjudicated of an A+ or A++ offense~~) Is adjudicated of
6 murder in the first degree (RCW 9A.32.030), or murder in the second
7 degree (RCW 9A.32.050);

8 (b) Is fourteen years of age or older and is adjudicated of one
9 or more of the following offenses:

10 (i) A class A offense, or an attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation
11 to commit a class A offense, except for robbery in the first degree
12 (RCW 9A.56.200);

13 (ii) Manslaughter in the first degree (RCW 9A.32.060);

14 (iii) Assault in the second degree (RCW 9A.36.021), extortion in
15 the first degree (RCW 9A.56.120), kidnapping in the second degree
16 (RCW 9A.40.030), drive-by shooting (RCW 9A.36.045), vehicular
17 homicide (RCW 46.61.520), hit and run death (RCW 46.52.020(4)(a)), or
18 manslaughter 2 (RCW 9A.32.070); or

19 (iv) Violation of the uniform controlled substances act (RCW
20 69.50.401(2) (a) and (b)), when the offense includes infliction of
21 bodily harm upon another or when during the commission or immediate
22 withdrawal from the offense the respondent was armed with a deadly
23 weapon;

24 (c) Is ordered to serve a disposition for a firearm violation
25 under RCW 13.40.193;

26 (d) Is adjudicated of ((a)) an offense under RCW
27 13.04.030(1)(e)(v) or a sex offense as defined in RCW 9.94A.030; or

28 (e) Has a prior option B disposition"

EFFECT: Restores current law on option B sentencing, which allows for suspended dispositions. Permits robbery in the first degree for an option B sentence. Replaces A+ and A++ with murder in the first

degree and murder in the second degree. Removes suspended dispositions under option A.
