the state to provide an annual cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for teachers and other public school employees, as well as community and technical college academic employees and classified employees at technical colleges based on the Seattle-area Consumer Price Index (CPI) from the most recently completed calendar year. Following enactment of Engrossed House Bill 2242 in 2017, the COLA for kindergarten through grade 12 school employees was changed to be based on the implicit price deflator (IPD). Community and technical college academic employees and classified employees at technical colleges still receive an annual COLA based on the Seattle-area CPI.

Summary of Bill:

The index used to calculate the annual COLA for community and technical college academic employees and classified employees at technical colleges is changed from the Seattle-area CPI to the IPD.
