1 AN ACT Relating to the retention of hospital medical records; and 2 amending RCW 70.41.190.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.41.190 and 1985 c 213 s 27 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 ((Unless specified otherwise by the department, a hospital shall 7 retain and preserve all medical records which relate directly to the 8 care and treatment of a patient for a period of no less than ten 9 years following the most recent discharge of the patient; except the 10 records of minors, which shall be retained and preserved for a period 11 of no less than three years following attainment of the age of 12 eighteen years, or ten years following such discharge, whichever is 13 longer.))

18 <u>(a) This subsection applies to:</u>

19 (i) Medical records created prior to the effective date of this 20 section and retained or preserved by the hospital on the effective 21 date of this section; and

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1 <u>(ii) Medical records created on or after the effective date of</u> 2 <u>this section.</u>

3 (b) This subsection does not apply to medical records no longer 4 retained and preserved by the hospital on the effective date of this 5 section if the hospital complied with this section as it existed 6 prior to the effective date of this section when it destroyed or 7 otherwise disposed of the records.

8 (c) This subsection does not exempt hospitals from compliance
9 with any other record retention requirements.

10 <u>(2)</u> If a hospital ceases operations, it shall make immediate 11 arrangements, as approved by the department, for preservation of its 12 records.

13 (3) The department shall by regulation define the type of records 14 and the information required to be included in the medical records to 15 be retained and preserved under this section; which records may be 16 retained in photographic form pursuant to chapter 5.46 RCW.

17 <u>(4) All information collected at each unique visit is considered</u> 18 <u>a medical record for purposes of this section.</u>

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
