AN ACT Relating to lowering taxes and providing smaller, smarter government by sunsetting all nonconstitutionally mandated state agencies, commissions, boards, task forces, work groups, and councils every 10 years absent affirmative reestablishment by the legislature; adding a new chapter to Title 43 RCW; and creating a new section.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that state agencies, commissions, boards, task forces, work groups, and councils that do 8 9 efficiently and effectively service the state's 10 priorities should be right-sized or dissolved. The legislature 11 further finds that requiring state government to regularly and 12 affirmatively review and reestablish every nonconstitutionally mandated state agency, commission, board, task force, work group, and 13 14 council will both reduce the tax burden on Washington individuals, 15 families, and businesses, and also help state government to better 16 address ever evolving and emerging demands and priorities placed on 17 its limited resources.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) Beginning July 1, 2027, and every 10 years thereafter, each state agency, commission, board, task force, work group, and council of the executive, judicial, and legislative

- 1 branch except for those specified in subsection (2) of this section,
- 2 are automatically dissolved unless affirmatively reestablished by
