- 1 WHEREAS, An estimated 54 million Americans have osteoporosis or 2 low bone mass, and studies suggest that approximately one in two 3 women and up to one in four men aged 50 and older will break a bone 4 due to osteoporosis; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Osteoporosis-related bone fractures account for more 6 hospitalizations than heart attacks, strokes, or breast cancer; and
- WHEREAS, Osteoporosis is often referred to as a "silent disease" because individuals cannot feel their bones weakening; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Timely bone health screening, diagnosis, and treatment 10 can help prevent fractures that may lead to hospitalizations and 11 long-term nursing home stays; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Cost-effective postfracture care, which improves care 13 coordination, has been shown to reduce the number of subsequent or 14 repeat fractures; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Osteoporosis and the associated broken bones are not an 16 inevitable part of aging—building strong bones begins in childhood 17 and remains essential throughout life, with peak bone mass typically 18 reached by early adulthood; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Optimum bone health and osteoporosis prevention can be 20 achieved through a balanced diet rich in calcium and vitamin D, 21 weight-bearing and muscle-strengthening exercises, and a healthy 22 lifestyle free from smoking and excessive alcohol consumption; and
