- 1 AN ACT Relating to emergency response systems in public schools
- 2 including panic or alert buttons; and amending RCW 28A.320.126.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.320.126 and 2019 c 333 s 16 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) School districts must work collaboratively with local law enforcement agencies, public safety answering points, and ((school)
- 8 security personnel)) safety and security staff as defined in RCW
- 9 <u>28A.320.124</u> to develop an emergency response system using evolving
- 10 technology to expedite the response and arrival of law enforcement in
- 11 the event of a threat or emergency at a school. ((School districts
- 12 are encouraged to use the model policies developed by the school
- 13 safety center in the office of the superintendent of public
- 14 instruction as a resource.)) "Emergency response system" includes at
- 15 least one of the following:
- 16 (a) Panic or alert buttons that are tied to school
- 17 <u>administration</u>, <u>school</u> <u>district</u> <u>staff</u>, <u>and</u> <u>emergency</u> <u>response</u>
- 18 providers;
- 19 (b) Live video feed with law enforcement, school district, and
- 20 school access;

(d) Remote control access to doors; or

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- (e) Live interactive two-way communications.
- 5 (2) Each school district must submit a progress report on its 6 implementation of an emergency response system as required under this 7 section to the office of the superintendent of public instruction by ((December 1, 2014)) October 1, 2025. By December 1, 2025, the office 8 of the superintendent of public instruction must compile the 9 information submitted by school districts and report to the 10 legislature on the types of emergency response systems used by school 11 12 districts.
- 13 (3) This section governs school operation and management under
 14 RCW 28A.710.040 and 28A.715.020 and applies to charter schools
 15 established under chapter 28A.710 RCW and state-tribal education
 16 compact schools subject to chapter 28A.715 RCW.

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
