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- AN ACT Relating to emergency response systems in public schools including panic or alert buttons; and amending RCW 28A.320.126.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.320.126 and 2019 c 333 s 16 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) School districts must work collaboratively with local law enforcement agencies and ((school security personnel)) safety and

security staff as defined in RCW 28A.320.124 to develop an emergency

- 9 response system using evolving technology to expedite the response
- 10 and arrival of law enforcement in the event of a threat or emergency
- 11 at a school. (($\frac{School}{districts}$ are encouraged to use the model
- 12 policies developed by the school safety center in the office of the
- 13 superintendent of public instruction as a resource.)) "Emergency
- 14 <u>response system" includes:</u>
- 15 <u>(a) Panic or alert buttons that are tied to school</u>
- 16 <u>administration</u>, <u>school</u> <u>district</u> <u>staff</u>, <u>and</u> <u>emergency</u> <u>response</u>
- 17 providers;

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- 18 (b) Live video feed with law enforcement, school district, and
- 19 <u>school access;</u>
- 20 (c) Live audio feed with law enforcement, school district, and

21 school access;

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1	(d) Remote control access to doors;
2	(e) Live interactive two-way communications; or
3	(f) Interconnection with an alert and communication system
4	maintained by the Washington association of sheriffs and police
5	chiefs.
6	(2) Each school district must submit a progress report on its
7	implementation of an emergency response system as required under this
8	section to the office of the superintendent of public instruction by
9	((December 1, 2014)) October 1, 2025. By December 1, 2025, the office
10	of the superintendent of public instruction must compile the
11	information submitted by school districts and report to the
12	legislature on the types of emergency response systems used by school
13	districts.
14	(3) This section governs school operation and management under
15	RCW 28A.710.040 and 28A.715.020 and applies to charter schools
16	established under chapter 28A.710 RCW and state-tribal education
17	compact schools subject to chapter 28A.715 RCW.

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
