## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 5065

State of Washington 69th Legislature 2025 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting the use of certain animals in 2 traveling animal acts; adding a new chapter to Title 9 RCW; and 3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The definitions in this section apply 6 throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires 7 otherwise.

8 (1) "Covered animal" means any of the following animals, and 9 hybrids thereof:

10 (a) Elephantidae;

11 (b) Felidae, including any hybrids thereof, but excluding 12 domestic cats;

13 (c) Nonhuman primate; and

14 (d) Ursidae.

(2) "Mobile or traveling housing facility" means a transporting
 vehicle such as a truck, trailer, or railway car, used to transport
 or house animals while traveling for exhibition or other performance.
 (3) "Performance" means any exhibition, public showing,

19 presentation, display, exposition, fair, animal act, circus, ride, 20 trade show, petting zoo, carnival, parade, race, or similar 21 undertaking in which animals are required to perform tricks, give

rides, or participate as accompaniments for the entertainment,
 amusement, or benefit of a live audience.

3 (4) "Person" means individuals, corporations, partnerships,
4 associations, or other legal entities, and agents of those entities.

5 (5) "Traveling animal act" means any performance of animals where 6 such animals are transported to, from, or between locations for the 7 purpose of such performance, in a mobile or traveling housing 8 facility.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of 10 law, no person shall allow for the participation of a covered animal 11 in a traveling animal act.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This chapter shall not apply to a 13 performance that: (1) Takes place at a nonmobile, permanent 14 institution or other fixed facility licensed by the United States 15 department of agriculture; and (2) is conducted by the nonmobile, 16 permanent institution or fixed facility.

17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A violation of this chapter is a gross 18 misdemeanor.

19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. A city or county may adopt an ordinance 20 governing traveling animal acts that is more restrictive than this 21 chapter.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. Sections 1 through 5 of this act 23 constitute a new chapter in Title 9 RCW.

24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. If any provision of this act or its 25 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 26 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 27 persons or circumstances is not affected.
