- 1 AN ACT Relating to leaving a child unattended in a vehicle;
- 2 amending RCW 9.91.060; prescribing penalties; and making an
- 3 appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.91.060 and 1999 c 143 s 9 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- (1) Every person having the care and custody, whether temporary or permanent, of minor children under the age of ((twelve)) 12 years, who shall leave such children in a parked automobile unattended by an adult while such person enters a tavern or other premises where vinous, spirituous, or malt liquors are dispensed for consumption on
- 12 the premises shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
- (2) A person who has the care and custody, whether temporary or
- 14 permanent, of a minor child under the age of nine years, and
- 15 knowingly leaves the child unattended by an adult in a parked
- 16 <u>automobile</u>, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of \$100,000, or as much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 19 2026, from the general fund to the department of health, for the
