- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 5
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.21C 7 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 (1) Decisions listed in subsection (3) of this section are subject to the requirements of RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c) pertaining to 9 10 cultural resources, unless the branch of government has:
- 11 (a) A data-sharing agreement with the department of archaeology 12 and historic preservation;
- 13 (b) Either a local ordinance protecting archaeological and historic properties or a cultural resource management plan approved 14 by the department of archaeology and historic preservation; and 15
- (c) A written consultation agreement approved by affected 16 17 federally recognized tribes.
- (2) The department of archaeology and historic preservation shall 18 19 develop minimum standards that must be included in a local ordinance 20 protecting archaeological and historic properties under subsection (1) (b) of this section.

- 1 (3) This section applies to decisions pertaining to proposed 2 actions that are categorically exempt:
 - (a) Pursuant to RCW 43.21C.229;
- 4 (b) Pursuant to RCW 43.21C.240;

- 5 (c) As identified through rule making conducted pursuant to RCW 43.21C.110; and
- 7 (d) Pursuant to other statutes enacted or rules adopted 8 establishing a categorical exemption on or after the effective date 9 of this section.
