2 services report recommendations addressing a regulatory oversight
3 plan for continuing care retirement communities; and amending RCW
4 18.390.080 and 18.390.030.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.390.080 and 2016 c 183 s 8 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 ~~((1))~~ The legislature finds that the ~~((violation of the title~~

5 ~~(2) The attorney general shall provide notice to the management~~
6 ~~of the continuing care retirement community of submitted complaints~~
7 ~~including the name of the complainant to allow the community to take~~
8 ~~corrective action. Except for violations of the title protection~~
9 ~~requirements of RCW 18.390.050 and the failure of a continuing care~~
10 ~~retirement community to register with the department under RCW~~
11 ~~18.390.020, the attorney general shall limit its application of the~~
12 ~~consumer protection act in subsection (1) of this section to those~~
13 ~~cases in which a pattern of complaints, submitted by affected~~
14 ~~parties, or other activity that, when considered together,~~
15 ~~demonstrate a pattern of similar conduct that, without enforcement,~~
16 ~~likely establishes an unfair or deceptive act in trade or commerce~~
17 ~~and an unfair method of competition.))~~ practices covered by this
18 chapter are matters vitally affecting the public interest for the
19 purpose of applying the consumer protection act, chapter 19.86 RCW. A
20 violation of this chapter is not reasonable in relation to the
21 development and preservation of business and is an unfair or
22 deceptive act in trade or commerce and an unfair method of
23 competition for the purpose of applying the consumer protection act,
24 chapter 19.86 RCW.

25 **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.390.030 and 2016 c 183 s 3 are each amended to
26 read as follows:

27 (1) An applicant for a registration as a continuing care
28 retirement community must submit the following materials to the
29 department:

30 (a) A written application to the department providing all
31 necessary information on a form provided by the department;

32 (b) Information about the licensed assisted living facility
33 component of the continuing care retirement community and, if the
34 continuing care retirement community operates a nursing home,
35 information about that component;

36 (c) Copies of any residency agreements that the continuing care
37 retirement community intends to use for the certification period;

38 (d) A written statement indicating whether the residency
39 agreement includes an entrance fee in lieu of payment for future care

1 and services and, if so, whether those services are covered
2 completely or partially by the entrance fee;

3 (e) A copy of the disclosure statement that includes current
4 information required by RCW 18.390.060;

5 ~~((e))~~ (f)(i) Except as provided in ~~((e))~~ (f)(ii) of this
6 subsection, copies of audited financial statements for the two most
7 recent fiscal years. The audited financial statement for the most
8 current period may not have been prepared more than eighteen months
9 prior to the date that the continuing care retirement community
10 applied for its current registration;

11 (ii) If the continuing care retirement community:

12 (A) Has obtained financing, but has been in operation less than
13 two years, a copy of the audited financial statement for the most
14 current period, if available, and an independent accountant's report
15 opinion letter that has evaluated the financial feasibility of the
16 continuing care retirement community; or

17 (B) Has not obtained financing, a summary of the actuarial
18 analysis for the new continuing care retirement community stating
19 that the continuing care retirement community is in satisfactory
20 actuarial balance;

21 ~~((f))~~ (g) An attestation by a management representative of the
22 continuing care retirement community that the continuing care
23 retirement community is in compliance with the disclosure
24 notification requirements of RCW 18.390.060; and

25 ~~((g))~~ (h) Payment of any registration fees associated with the
26 department's cost of registering continuing care retirement
27 communities.

28 (2) The department shall base its decision to issue a
29 registration on the completeness of the application. If an
30 application is incomplete, the department shall inform the applicant
31 and give the applicant an opportunity to supplement its submission.
32 An applicant may appeal a decision of the department to deny an
33 application for registration.

34 (3) The department shall issue the registration within sixty days
35 of the receipt of a complete application, payment of fees, submission
36 of disclosures, residency agreements, and the attestation. The
37 department's failure to timely issue a registration may not cause a
38 delay in the change of ownership and ongoing operation of the
39 continuing care retirement community.

40 (4) Registration is valid for two years.

1 (5) Registration is not transferable.

2 (6) Materials submitted pursuant to this section are not subject
3 to disclosure under the public records act, chapter 42.56 RCW.
