

RCW 46.16A.520 Allowing unauthorized person to drive—Penalty.

It is unlawful for any person in whose name a vehicle is registered knowingly to permit another person to drive the vehicle when the other person is not authorized to do so under the laws of this state. A violation of this section is a misdemeanor. [1987 c 388 § 10. Formerly RCW 46.16.011.]
