

(e) If the application is being made for a loan, a repayment plan;

(f) The number of communities to be served by the proposed project;

(g) Tax rates imposed by the applicant local government for taxes whose revenues can be used to finance public works projects; and

(h) Utility rates charged for sewerage, water, garbage, and other utilities.

(5) Any application for financial assistance submitted to the board shall be signed and verified by a responsible official of the applicant jurisdiction. Such official shall also provide the board with any additional materials or information in support of the application which the board or its staff may request. [Statutory Authority: 1985 c 446 § 10. 85-24-072 (Order 85-17), § 399-30-030, filed 12/4/85.]

WAC 399-30-050 Recommendations to the legislature. (1) Prior to November 1, 1986, and in each subsequent year, the board shall develop and submit to the ways and means committees of the senate and house of representatives a prioritized list of projects which the board recommends for funding by the legislature. In the board's first year of operation, the board shall submit this list to the ways and means committees by February 1, 1986.

(2) In addition to the requirements of RCW 43.155.070(6), the list will include such supporting material as the board considers necessary to meet the purposes of this chapter. [Statutory Authority: 1985 c 446 § 10. 85-24-072 (Order 85-17), § 399-30-050, filed 12/4/85.]

WAC 399-30-060 Loan and financing guarantee contracts. (1) The board shall not sign contracts or otherwise financially obligate funds from the public works assistance account until the list is in final form and the appropriations are received from the legislature.

(2) After the legislature has appropriated funds from the public works assistance account for a specific list of public works projects, the loan funds will be disbursed to the applicant local government pursuant to a contract therefor, which will be offered to the local government with such reasonable terms and conditions as the board may determine: *Provided*, That the amount loaned to a local government shall not exceed ninety percent of eligible proposed project cost: *Provided further*, That the interest rate for loans shall not exceed three percent per annum: *Provided further*, That loans shall not exceed twenty years in duration, or the useful life of the improvements, whichever is shorter. Exception to these provisions shall be made only in cases of severe economic distress and/or natural disaster.

(3) Public works project loan and/or financing guarantee contracts offered to local governments shall be executed by the local government and an original contract returned to the board prior to the disbursement of any funds thereunder. WAC 415-02-090 Actuarial tables, schedules, and factors. This chapter contains the tables, schedules, and factors adopted by the director of the department of retirement systems pursuant to the Authority granted by RCW 41.04.050, 41.26.060, 41.32.150, 41.40.065, and 43.43.200 for calculating optional retirement allowances of members of retirement systems administered by the director. These tables, schedules, and factors were adopted by the director upon the recommendation of and in light of the findings of the state actuary in his regular actuarial investigation into the mortality, service, compensation, and other experience of the members and beneficiaries of such retirement systems. The tables, schedules, and factors contained in this chapter shall govern the retirement allowances only of members retiring during the period from February 1, 1983 until such

time as these tables, schedules, and factors are amended by the director following the next actuarial investigation conducted by the state actuary. The retirement allowances of members retiring before February 1, 1983 shall continue to be governed by the tables, schedules, and factors in effect at the time of each member's retirement. Any new tables, schedules, and factors adopted by the director in the future shall govern retirement allowances only of members retiring after the adoption of such new tables, schedules, and factors.

WAC 415-02-100 Retiree insurance premium deductions for retirees--Enrollment requirements. Effective December 1, 1984 the department of retirement systems will not accept requests by retirees of any of the systems which the department administers to deduct premiums for any kind of insurance from retirement allowances unless the provider has at least twenty-five such retirees enrolled in a withholding program. Any providers who now have less than twenty-five retirees in their deduction program will have twelve months in which to secure at least twenty-five participants. Failing to acquire the required minimum within twelve months will result in suspension of the deduction program for such provider. Any provider presently qualified who drops below twenty-five participants in the future will be suspended if they remain under twenty-five participants for ninety days. 415-104-510 Minimum standards for membership—Physical examination.

WAC 415-104-510 Minimum standards for membership--Physical examination. (1) **Requirements:** (a) Medical examination administered by a licensed physician or surgeon as set forth under provisions of chapter 18.71 RCW. Physician or surgeon to be appointed by the appropriate city or county disability board. Causes for rejection will be consistent with recommendations outlined in these standards.

(b) A medical history will be supplied by each applicant to the examining physician. The medical history will include information on past and present diseases, injuries, and operations.

(c) The applicant must possess normal vision. He must demonstrate normal visual functions and visual acuity not less than 20/100 vision in each eye without correction and corrected to 20/20 in the better eye and 20/30 in the lesser eye. He must possess normal color vision.

(d) Applicant must possess normal hearing. Hearing acuity level to be determined by audiometric hearing test.

(e) Applicant must be at least eighteen years of age, and shall not have reached forty-five years of age at the time of appointment.

(f) Retention on a permanent basis by the employer of the results of the physical examination on all applicants employed under these standards is required.

(2) **Procedure:** (a) Completion of the report of medical history by the applicant.

(b) The physical examination will be conducted by a licensed physician or surgeon after a review of the report of medical history completed by the applicant.

(c) The physician shall record his findings on the report of medical history and shall note thereon, for evaluation by the hiring authority, any past or present physical defects, diseases, injuries, operations, or conditions of an abnormal or unusual nature and whether applicant is or is not qualified. Reports of medical history shall be typewritten or printed, and the summary of defects and diagnosis shall refer to the applicable section of these standards as cause for rejection.

(d) Physical examination reports shall be placed in permanent files by the employer and must be available for examination at any reasonable time by representatives of the retirement system board.
