WAC 296-876-60045 Step-across distance. (1) You must make sure a through ladder at the point of access or egress has a step-across distance, measured from the centerline of the steps or rungs to the nearest edge of the landing area, that is:

- (a) Not less than seven inches; or
- (b) Greater than twelve inches.

(2) You must make sure a side-step ladder at the point of access or egress has a step-across distance, measured from the side rail of the ladder to the nearest edge of the landing area, that is:

- (a) Not less than seven inches; or
- (b) Greater than twelve inches.
