WAC 296-876-70010 Inspection and repair. (1) You must keep ladders in safe condition.

(2) You must have a competent person inspect a ladder for visual defects:

(a) Periodically; and

(b) After any occurrence that could affect safe use.

(3) You must make sure any ladder with structural damage or other hazardous defect is immediately removed from service.

Notes: 1. Structural damage includes, but is not limited to, any of the following:

a. Broken or missing rungs, cleats, or steps.

b. Broken or split rails.

c. Corroded components. d. Bolts and welds missing or not secure.

2. A ladder is considered to be removed from service if any of the following are done:

- a. It is marked to identify it as defective.
- b. It is targed with "do not use" or similar language.c. It is blocked so that it cannot be used, for example, by using a plywood attachment that spans several rungs.

(4) You must make sure repairs restore the ladder to a condition meeting its original design criteria.
