

WAC 388-71-01205 When does APS notify the alleged perpetrator of a substantiated initial finding? (1) APS will notify the alleged perpetrator in writing within ten working days of making a substantiated initial finding of abandonment, abuse, financial exploitation or neglect of a vulnerable adult.

(2) The time frame for notification can be extended beyond ten working days to include the time needed to translate the notification letter or make provisions for the safety of the alleged victim.
