

WAC 390-17-015 Conduit—Definition. (1) "Conduit," as that term is used in the act and these rules, is defined as a person, other than an individual, that receives and spends earmarked contributions on behalf of a designated candidate, bona fide political party, caucus of the state legislature or other political committee.

(2) Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.470, a conduit may not make or transmit contributions on behalf of another.
