

WAC 200-340-100 Factors to be considered. Factors which should be considered by a city, town or county when deciding whether to follow or deviate from the design, surface textures and/or location standards set forth in this chapter include, but are not limited to, the following:

- (1) Street alignments and curb configurations that are substantially different from the curb situations shown.
- (2) An adjacent driveway or loading ramp.
- (3) Unusual sidewalk textures in the vicinity.
- (4) Steeper street grades.
- (5) Utility vaults.
- (6) Whether a different design or location would assist the handicapped pedestrian without uniquely endangering the blind.
