

WAC 296-307-24027 Employer provided change rooms. (1) Whenever employees are required by a WISHA standard to wear protective clothing because of the possibility of contamination with toxic materials, the employer must provide change rooms with separate storage facilities for street clothes and for the protective clothing.

(2) If the employer provides work clothes for employees, they must be dry.
