Proposed Permit: The Washington state department of ecology (ecology) is proposing to reissue the general permit to regulate the use of herbicides, algacides, adjuvants and phosphorous inactivation products for control of noxious weeds, nuisance plants, algae and phosphorous in surface waters of Washington state.

Washington's water quality statutes and regulations do not allow the discharge of pollutants to waters of the state without permit coverage. The herbicides, algacides, adjuvants and phosphorous inactivation products are potential pollutants, and therefore require a discharge permit before application to surface waters. Ecology issues general permits in place of a series of individual permits when the permitted activities are similar.

Ecology, the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) lead for this permit, has determined that this proposal is likely to have significant adverse impacts on the environment. Ecology has made the SEPA determination available for review and comment at http://www.ecy.wa.gov/programs/wq/pesticides/final_pesticide_permits/aquatic_plants/aquatic_plant permit index.html.

Purpose of the Permit: The aquatic plant and algae management general permit is a national pollutant discharge elimination system (NPDES) permit, which regulates the use of herbicides, algacides, adjuvants and phosphorous inactivation products for control of noxious weeds, nuisance plants, algae and phosphorous in surface waters of Washington state.
