Document Title: Public Notice.

Subject: Amendment to residential support waiver.

Effective Date: Upon approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

The agency and DSHS intend to submit an amendment to the residential support waiver (RSW) WA.1086. This waiver will be amended to include retainer payments, and add adult day health (ADH) and expanded community services (ECS) as new waiver services. The cost neutrality section will also be updated to reflect updated medical costs and the enrollment limit will be increased to accommodate enrollees who will access these new waiver services.

ADH is a supervised daytime program providing nursing and rehabilitative therapy services to adults with medical or disabling conditions that require the intervention or services of a registered nurse, or a licensed speech therapist, occupational therapist or physical therapist acting under the supervision of the participant's physician when required.

ECS will provide waiver participants with additional supports to address complex behavior. ECS services include specialized residential services and behavior supports provided by contracted providers with expertise in this area. Adding these services to the RSW will provide waiver participants with a broader array of service options and choice of providers.

This change will be effective upon approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

**Announcing the Issuance of the Upland Fin-Fish Hatching and Rearing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit and Fact Sheet**

The Washington state department of ecology (ecology) is reissuing the upland fin-fish hatching and rearing NPDES waste discharge general permit (permit). The previous permit expired on August 1, 2015, and was administratively extended. The new permit and fact sheet, which explains the technical bases for the permit, will be published on the ecology web site on **December 16, 2015**, and is available as described below. The new permit will be in effect for a term of five years, from the effective date of April 1, 2016, through March 31, 2021.

**Purpose of the Permit:** The permit implements the Federal Clean Water Act; the State Water Pollution Control Act; and chapter 172-221A [173-221A] WAC, Wastewater discharge standards and effluent limitations. The purpose of the upland fin-fish hatching and rearing general permit is to regulate the discharge of pollutants from upland fin-fish hatching and rearing facilities into waters of the state. Dischargers who require coverage under this permit include all state and private hatcheries that produce more than twenty thousand pounds of fish per year or feed more than five thousand pounds of feed per month. The permit contains best management practices and effluent limitations and monitoring requirements necessary to protect state water quality.

**Summary of Public Involvement:** On August 19, 2015, ecology published the proposed permit and fact sheet on its web site, and in the Washington State Register (WSR 15-16-111) and through about two hundred thirty-five e-mails and letters, announcing the sixty-one day public review and comment period (from August 19 through October 19, 2015). Ecology held a public workshop and hearing at its headquarters building in Lacey, Washington, on September 28, 2015, to discuss the draft documents and to receive oral and written comments. Ecology also accepted e-mailed comments during that sixty-one day period. Ecology responded to all of the comments, as described in the fact sheet.

**Applying for Coverage Under the Permit:** Facilities that applied for coverage and are covered under the existing general permit will also be covered under the new permit. New or unpermitted facilities may obtain coverage under the new permit by submitting a complete permit application to ecology and satisfying all applicable public notice and State Environmental Policy Act requirements (WAC 173-226-200). The application for coverage is available online at <https://fortress.wa.gov/ecy/publications/SummaryPages/ECY04072.html>.

**Appeal Procedures:** In accordance with **chapter 43.21B RCW**, the terms and conditions of this permit may be

appealed within thirty days of the issuance of the permit. An appeal must be filed in writing to both the pollution control hearings board and ecology at the addresses provided below. Appeals may not be delivered by e-mail.

The terms and conditions of this permit, *as they apply to an individual discharger*, may be appealed within thirty days of the effective date of coverage of that discharger, in accordance with **chapter 43.21B RCW**. This type of appeal is limited to the permit's applicability or nonapplicability to a specific discharger.

#### Notice of Administrative Policy Statements

**Policy #11-3: Correcting employing agency enrollment errors.** This policy clarifies the requirements placed on an employing agency when the employing agency corrects its enrollment errors as described in WAC 182-08-187.

**Policy #15-1: Determining eligibility for seasonal employees and maintenance of employer contribution through the off-season.** This policy clarifies seasonal employee eligibility for PEBB benefits and the employer contribution.

**Policy #19-1: Termination due to loss of eligibility.** This policy applies whenever coverage for a subscriber or a subscriber's dependent is terminated due to loss of eligibility.

**Addendum #19-1A: Termination due to loss of eligibility: Employee.**

**Addendum #19-1B: Termination due to loss of eligibility: Self-pay subscriber.**

**Policy #21-1: Retiree deferral form exemption.** This policy exempts certain retirees from the procedural requirement of completing a deferral form in WAC 182-12-171 (1)(a) and 182-12-205(2).

**Policy #31-1: Verifying dependent eligibility before enrollment.** This policy clarifies which documents the PEBB program considers valid for dependent verification.

**Policy #31-2: Use of premium surcharge help sheet and spousal plan calculator tools.** This policy provides direction when a PEBB subscriber enrolled in PEBB medical, but not enrolled in Medicare Part A and Part B in which Medicare is the primary payer, is determining if he or she must pay a premium surcharge for an enrolled spouse or registered domestic partner who elected not to enroll in his or her employer-based group medical insurance.

**Policy #37-1: Certifying eligibility for an extended dependent child.** This policy applies when a subscriber submits the required forms to enroll an extended dependent child in the subscriber's PEBB benefits.

**Policy #45-2: Special Open Enrollment (SOE).** This policy applies whenever a subscriber requests an enrollment change or election change outside of the PEBB annual open enrollment.

**Addendum #45-2A: Special Open Enrollment (SOE) matrix:** Summary of permitted election changes.

**Policy #91-1: Requesting a reasonable alternative for completing wellness incentive program requirements or avoiding the tobacco use premium surcharge.** This policy applies when a subscriber who is eligible to participate in the PEBB wellness incentive program is seeking a reasonable alternative to a wellness incentive program requirement in order to receive a wellness incentive as described in WAC 182-12-300. This policy also applies when an enrollee on a PEBB medical plan is seeking a reasonable alternative so that a subscriber can avoid paying the tobacco premium surcharge as described in WAC 182-08-185 (1)(c).
