Title or Subject: Tribal Mental Health Services Fee-for-Service - Medicaid State Plan Amendment 17-0016.

Effective Date: July 1, 2017.

Description: The health care authority (the agency) and the behavioral health administration (BHA) within the department of social and health services intend to submit medicaid state plan amendment (SPA) 17-0016 in order to implement a fee-for-service (FFS) medicaid payment system for specialty mental health services provided to American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) medicaid enrollees. Currently, AI/AN enrollees must access specialty mental health services through a managed care system. SPA 17-0016 will allow mental health agencies to provide services to AI/AN enrollees on an FFS basis. The SPA is anticipated to be effective July 1, 2017.

SPA 17-0016 will give AI/AN enrollees the choice to opt in to managed care mental health services or remain in the FFS system. Qualified mental health providers will be able to serve AI/AN enrollees and be paid through the FFS system.

At this time, it is not clear what effect SPA 17-0016 may have on the annual aggregate expenditures for medicaid-funded community mental health services. Payments to mental health providers under the current system are based on a per-member-per-month rate that incorporates a number of factors that are not considered in an FFS system. In the FFS system, providers are paid per service. In addition, the FFS system is a voluntary system for both providers and AI/AN medicaid enrollees. There is currently no data available to indicate how many providers will be willing to provide FFS services or how many AI/AN individuals will choose to remain in the FFS system.

SPA 17-0016 is in the development process; therefore a copy is not yet available for review. The agency and BHA would appreciate any input or concerns regarding this SPA.

Announcing the Issuance of the Final Modification of the Construction Stormwater General Permit

The Washington state department of ecology (ecology) modified the construction stormwater national pollutant discharge elimination system and state waste discharge general permit (permit) as a result of an appeal. The current permit issued November 18, 2015, was appealed December 21, 2015. The draft permit modification was available for public comment December 21, 2016, to February 10, 2017, and ecology hosted a draft permit modification informational public workshop and public hearing on February 10, 2017. Ecology prepared a fact sheet addendum and response to comments for the draft permit modification. The final permit modification goes into effect May 5, 2017.

Permit Changes: The permit changes are to dust control (S1.C.3.i), pH sampling requirements (S4.D), engineering calculation requirements (S9.B.1.f), and concrete washout (S9.D.9.h).

Purpose of the Permit: The permit authorizes the discharge of stormwater and authorized nonstormwater associated with construction activity. The permit covers all areas of Washington state, except most tribal lands (the permit does cover most of the Puyallup Reservation).

The construction stormwater general permit (CSWGP) limits the discharge of pollutants to surface waters under the authority of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1251) and limits the discharge of pollutants to surface and groundwater under the authority of the State Water Pollution Control Act, chapter 90.48 RCW.

Applying for Coverage under the Permit: New or unpermitted construction sites may obtain coverage under CSWGP by submitting a complete notice of intent (permit coverage application) to ecology and satisfying all applicable public notice and State Environmental Policy Act requirements (WAC 173-226-200). Title or Subject: Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) 17-0013 Third Party Liability.

Effective Date: April 2017.

Description: The health care authority (the agency) intends to submit medicaid SPA 17-0013 in order to amend the current language under Attachment 4.22-A (#3): "Requirements for Third Party Liability - Identifying Liable Resources" to align with the Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) 433.138: "Identifying Liable Third Parties - diagnosis and trauma code edits" (5)(e). This section of the C.F.R. specifies "the agency must take action to identify paid claims for medicaid beneficiaries that contain diagnosis codes indicative of trauma, or injury, poisoning, or other consequences of external causes, for the purpose of determining the legal liability of third parties so that the agency may process claims under the third party liability payment procedures specified in 433.139 (b) through (f)." While the agency will continue to omit specific diagnosis codes from reclamation efforts due to the limited recovery they offer, the listing of the excluded diagnosis codes, currently displayed on Appendix A to attachment 4.22-A, will be removed.

Additionally, the agency will modify the frequency of treatment questionnaires (TQ) that are automatically generated in the medicaid management information system and sent to medicaid beneficiaries to gain clarification on the accident or incident that led to the paid claim, from two additional requests to one if the beneficiary does not respond to the original TQ letter timely. Eliminating the final TQ notification will allow the health care authority coordination of benefits office to further align with the Affordable Care Act requiring individuals have comparable health insurance, by removing the stipulation that the medicaid beneficiary may lose their medicaid eligibility if they fail to comply with the final TQ request.

SPA 17-0013 is expected to have no effect on the annual aggregate expenditures for all benefits and services since the change does not affect payments made to fee-for-service providers.
