- The settings in which SBIRT services may be provided are being amended to reflect current policy and practice.
 These settings include medical and community health care settings such as primary care centers, hospital emergency rooms, trauma centers, and dental offices.

SPA 17-0026 allows providers to furnish SBIRT services in a greater variety of settings. The agency anticipates this increased client access to services may result in an increased number of billings from providers, but there is no data available to verify this expectation. Therefore the agency is unable to calculate an effect on the aggregate expenditures for providing SBIRT services.
