**ETA 3043.2017 - Low-Density Light and Power Utility Deduction**

The department of revenue has revised ETA 3043. This ETA explains the public utility tax deduction provided by RCW 82.16.053 to qualifying power and light businesses.

RCW 82.16.053 requires the department to determine the state average electric power rate each year and inform taxpayers of this rate. This rate is used by power and light businesses to compute the amount of the deduction. The revised ETA 3043 updates the information to provide the rate for the period of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.

Title or Subject: Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) 17-0025 Telemedicine.

Effective Date: July 1, 2017.

Description: The health care authority (the agency) intends to submit Medicaid SPA 17-0025 in order to expand covered telemedicine services to include "store and forward" telecommunication-based services. "Store and forward" is the asynchronous transmission of medical information to be reviewed at a later time by the physician or practitioner at the distant site. The agency is adding this service in accordance with legislation passed in SSB 5175 during the 2015-2016 legislative session.

SPA 17-0025 is expected to have no effect on annual aggregate expenditures. Payment for "store and forward" is the same as for an in-person telemedicine visit, and providers may choose one or the other, but not both. In addition, as the agency introduces this service, it will be limited to dermatology so the agency can assess how it is used before expanding it for multiple specialties.

- For health care professionals who wish to qualify to provide SBIRT services, the agency is removing the four hour minimum requirement for SBIRT training, replacing it with the requirement to complete an agency-approved SBIRT training, which is waived if the provider has an addiction specialist certification and provides proof of the certification to the agency.
- The settings in which SBIRT services may be provided are being amended to reflect current policy and practice. These settings include medical and community health care settings such as primary care centers, hospital emergency rooms, trauma centers, and dental offices.

SPA 17-0026 allows providers to furnish SBIRT services in a greater variety of settings. The agency anticipates this increased client access to services may result in an increased number of billings from providers, but there is no data available to verify this expectation. Therefore the agency is unable to calculate an effect on the aggregate expenditures for providing SBIRT services.
